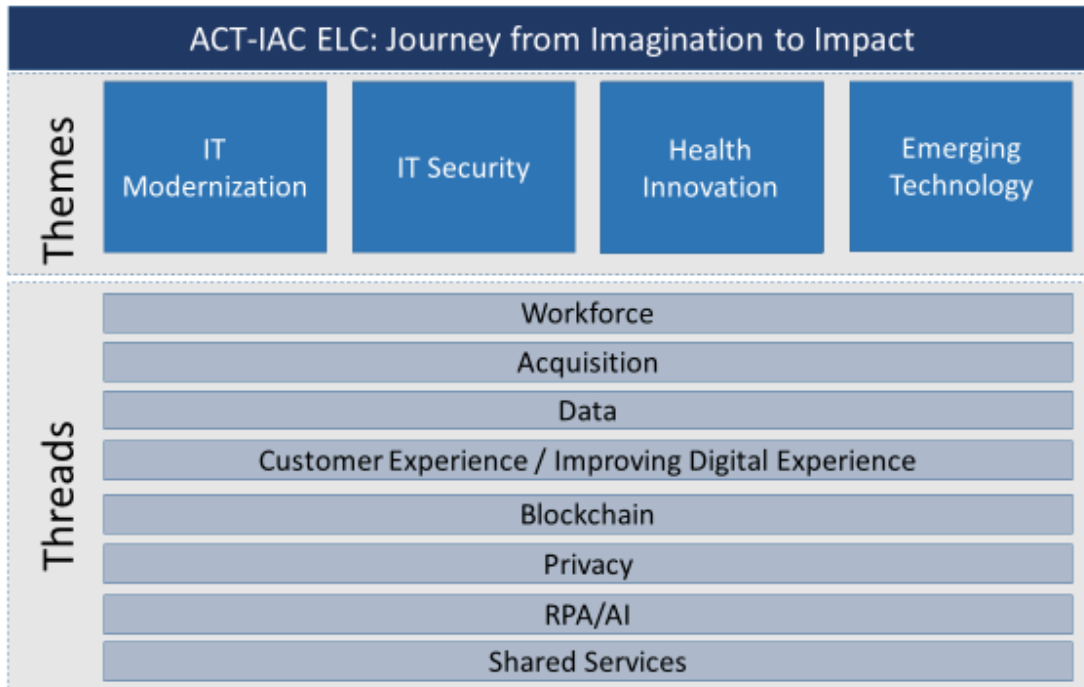

IMAGINE NATION ELC 2019 provides many opportunities for employees to develop competencies in both technical and leadership skills. These are only a sample of the core competencies employees can utilize in their performance and organizational goals.

Technical Core Competencies.

- **Problem Solving** – Government employees can work with teams to identify and analyze problems; weigh relevance and accuracy of information and generate solutions; or make recommendations.
- **Technology Management** – Government employees can experience hands-on the latest technological developments and learn the effective use of technology to achieve results.
- **Technical Credibility** – Government employees will engage in learning labs where they can apply principles, procedures, requirements and policies related to specialized expertise.
- **Creativity and Innovation** – Government employees will be able to develop new insights into situations and question conventional approaches through dialogue in track sessions.

Leadership/Management Core Competencies.

- **Partnering** – Government employees can develop networks and build alliances, actively collaborate with peers across boundaries to build strategic relationships and build consensus solutions in the innovation labs.
- **Customer Service** – Government employees can learn specific techniques in delivering high-quality products and services and commitment to continuous improvement.
- **Decisiveness** – Government employees can make effective and timely decisions even when information is limited, or solutions produce unfavorable consequences.

- **Political Savvy** – Government employees will engage in sessions and discussions that can assist in identifying internal and external politics in the organization and how to act accordingly.
